- b. If we're honest, how much of our time do we spend thinking about & trying to impress others?
 - i. Why do we have such a strong compulsion to impress others?
 - ii. What are we really trying to get?
 - iii. Does it work > do we get it?
- c. How would you define Humility?
- d. Since no one is more aware of our limitations & struggles than us > why isn't humility the natural posture of our heart?
