"Don't be afraid of those who want to kill your body; they cannot touch your soul. Fear only God, who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

What is the price of two sparrows—one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.

- a. Jesus saw how much fear our search for value creates > why is it so tough to find our value in God?
- b. We talked about humility last week > how could humility help us with our fear of others?
- c. If we continue to obey our fear of others > how will this affect the story that is written with our lives?
